5. Renewing Sustainable Neighbourhoods

General interest, but not great attendance for recent meetings, but trying a few strategies to encourage participation: phone calls, pop up stall, organising local Council events + upcoming Repair Cafe in Cameron Park.

Both groups focussed on developing SNAPs, and establishing governance and group culture.

6. Repair Café

7. ReLeaf

- New greening project / verge garden proposal from Valentine SNG. Progressing relatively quickly for approvals through Council. Rachelle assisting to prepare risk management plan, and will forward project plan and risk assessment to board for review when available.
- Ongoing maintenance at Blackalls Park and Styles Point. Noted with disappointment some vandalism at the Blackalls Park site.
- Tree Trail at the MAC. Website content finalised and ready for feedback. Brochure
 and signage in progress. <u>Launch event</u> preparation underway for 12 November.
 Congratulations to Robyn for huge amount of research and administrative work to
 get the trail ready for launch.
- Proposal for saltmarsh rehabilitation at one of the Styles Point sites. Working with Council and OzFish to confirm project plan and seek additional funding.

- Proposal from Deb Arthurs, Redhead SNG, possible bush regen / greening project. Robyn plans to follow up with her late November.
- ReLeaf raffle going well. \$695 in ticket sales to 31 Oct.
- Tiny forest
 - Application submitted for Council donation. For consideration at Council meeting 28 Nov.
 - Waiting for Council feedback on the draft concept design and ongoing project management and approval requirements. Aiming to complete earthworks in February.
 - EarthWatch citizen science possible train the trainer workshops week of 28 November, and complete baseline studies.
 - <u>Community info session webinar</u> scheduled for 16 November.
 - One response to community consultation, unhappy about potential loss of views. Have offered to meet with her, but no further correspondence to date.

8. Toronto Area – Waste and recycling

TASNG has discussed doing another fast food litter campaign and also a focus on problems with waste and recycling at Costco, Argenton in 2023. This is an extension of our recent Car boot sale to pass on used products and our graffiti campaign meeting on November 9, 5.30pm, Toronto Hub. There is scope here for lake-wide projects.

Noted approximately 50 sellers and public attendance at Saturday's Car Boot Sale.

The meeting discussed involvement in 2023 Plastic Free July regarding fast food deliveries, overpackaging at Costco and online deliveries. Discussion also covered strategies to focus SN efforts around waste management issues and what Councils and others' roles were, seeking the best way for SN to make an impact in this space. Raised idea of seeking a workshop style event with relevant Council staff.
