4.2 Business arising from the minutes

• Sponsorship proposal:

- **Update from Umwelt.** No response just yet. Colin's contact there is not available at the moment. They were very positive about the program and possibilities for a partnership, though, so Colin will pursue further when appropriate.
- Steve made contact with Suez Environnement, and sent them our Sponsorship Proposal and a request for a meeting. They suggested we look at their <u>Community Grants Program</u>, or considered approaching Council's residential recycling collection contractor. (Council has 2 waste contractors:

 - Remondis <u>http://www.remondis.com.au/en/reau/compliance-and-sustainability/community/</u> they currently sponsor KAB, and their website says "we hope to expand our sponsorships to support a greater diversity of worthy social and environmental enterprises." 9.1 Australia Day Award Winners

Congratulations to the 2016 Australia Day Award winners:

- West Wallsend District Sustainable Neighbourhood Group was awarded 2016 Community Event of the Year for their 'Old Waste, New Art' Competition.

9.2 Bunnings BBQ Fundraiser

West Wallsend, 14 Feb – Cancelled due to lack of volunteers for an expected very busy day.

9.3 Eco Angel Clean Up – Caves Beach-Swansea Area SNG, 31 January 2016

Event went well but relatively low volunteer numbers to split over 2 sites.

9.4 Dudley Nature Play project update

Looking at doing a series of workshops at the Dudley Healing Haven Markets. (Similar to what they did in November 2015.) Risk assessment has been requested to cover potential dates.

9.5 Hunter Water Community Consultative Forum

Norbert and Jean are registered as participants, and can add extra Alliance representatives as required.

Sustainable Neighbourhood groups can raise relevant queries or issues with the forum by contacting the Secretariat. Questions can be received up to a couple of days before the forum, but better to have some lead time for in-depth questions (eg 3-4 weeks). The next meeting of the Forum is 24 May.

Report back from Norbert who attended the first meeting on 2 February 2016, including:

- Contamination at the RAAF base at Williamtown. Detected by Hunter Water. Implications from contamination of the Tomago sand beds, and for the local community.
- Botanic Gardens Hunter Water sponsors them. Biobanking credits.
- New Managing Director at Hunter Water currently recruiting.
- IPART pricing review for Hunter Water's rates currently underway.
- + other items.

ACTION: Norbert to forward the meeting minute to Rachelle for circulation.

9.6 Plastic Bag Campaign

TASNG has approached every business along the Boulevarde to see if they are willing to go plastic bag free. Many (eg 60%) are already using paper bags, encouraging customers to bring their own etc. Have also publicised the campaign in the business chamber's newsletter. Remaining problem is with the big supermarkets. Also difficult to get butchers to find alternatives to plastic.

ACTION: Steve to resend Rachelle the list of Toronto champions to add to the website.

Redhead is also considering possible campaign to promote shopping locally, perhaps providing reusable bags to local businesses. Redhead volunteers have also been approaching their local businesses to develop a campaign.

9.7 Celebrate Dora Creek, 12 Dec

Fantastic day, with Mayor, Greg Piper and range of emergency service organisations. ~200 people attended over the course of the day.

9.8 Toronto Pathway Link - Successful grant (Community Building Partnership) – TASNG

The TASNG have received a grant from the NSW government for their project, "Improved pedestrian access and safety along Brighton Avenue, Toronto". The group have been notified that the costings originally provided by Council are inaccurate, and the funding provided is inadequate to complete the

project as planned. After a meeting on 16 February, Council staff and the group have agreed to work together to develop a solution. The group are now awaiting advice from Council about what the possibilities are to see the project completed to achieve the objectives of the grant.
