## Strengthen and connect our community

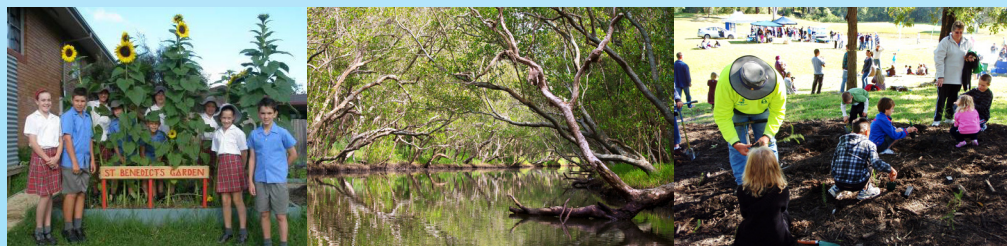
- Build a respectful, connected, and active community that cares for and supports each other, local businesses, community groups, schools, youth and the elderly.
