Old Waste, New Art (OWNA) Competition

The West Wallsend District Sustainable Neighbourhood Group will be holding its second art competition in conjunction with the Holmesville Billy Kart Derby to be held on the 8th October 2016. The broad theme of the competition will be "Waste in Society", and it will be known as OWNA ("Old Waste, New Art"). The inaugural event in 2015 won Lake Macquarie City Council's Australia Day Award for Best Community Event of the Year.

Entry is free and open to everyone, and will be judged in these three categories with the following prizes:

Primary School \$25

High School \$50 Open \$75

In addition, there will be a "People's Choice" award of \$50. Voting will be done on the day and will incur a 50 cent fee per vote, with any income being donated to "Mum's Cottage".

Entries will be judged on

- Creativity
- Skill
- Demonstration of recycling / messaging on the theme

Entries may be three dimensional (sculptures, functional items such as furniture, wearable items, etc.) and created predominantly from waste, or may be two dimensional (photographs, illustration, painting etc.) - reflecting waste in society. This is to help us allocate an appropriate space, that is, a table or wall space, but does not affect the categories or the judging.

To ensure that adequate display space is available registration is essential. There is no limit to the number of entries per person, but each entry must have a separate registration form. **The deadline for registration forms is 5**th **October 2016 to allow us time to plan the exhibits.** Each entry will be identified only by a number until after the judging; you will be allocated a random number upon receipt of the registration form. If you send the details of the second page to us in by Friday 7th October a display card will be printed to go with your entry.

The exhibition will be in the Holmesville Community Hall, with entries dropped in in the morning and picked up in the afternoon. The final arrangements will be confirmed closer to the event, and all participants will be advised.

Each entrant will receive a certificate of participation.
